



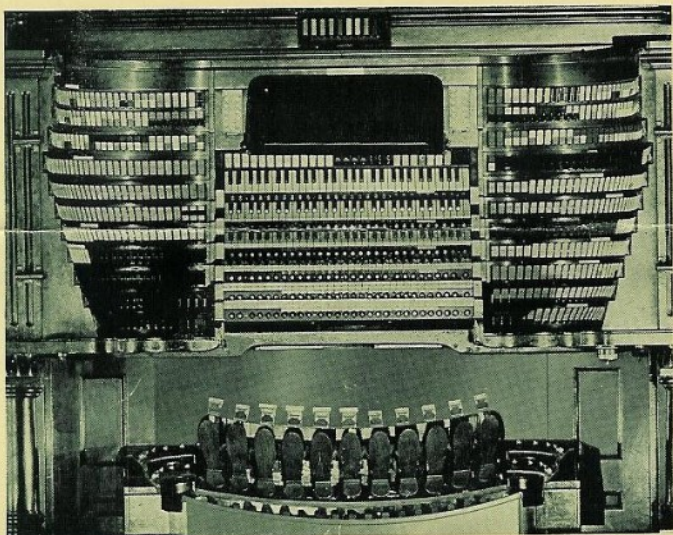

Console of the Great Organ

The keyboard has 964 controls, and all are within reach of the organist. The console's 729 tilting tablets are remote-controlled by the 168 pistons under the manual keys, of which there are 46 masters and 46 reversibles. There are also 42 accessories for the feet.

There are 10 expression pedals, six of them duplicated by long thumb slides on the key slips for hand operation. These expression devices can be coupled the same as the inter-manual couplers, being controlled by tilting stop tablets and the combination pistons.

Thirty-two regulators furnish wind pressure from 5 to 27 inches. The organ is electro-pneumatic throughout, requiring seven blowers and two generators, totaling 200 horsepower.
