-Delaware Organ Co., ca. 1961

Compasses: 58/27

Pitch and pressure: A436, w.p. lowered to 55mm (2 1/4"), new wind system
Original Hook stops with mechanical drawknob stop action.
New slide tuners throughout.

[8] Op. Diap'n. C-F# stopt wood, G-f#° zinc, façade; from g° interior,
spotted. Repitched ½ step @ g° *
[4] Octave C-E zinc, remainder common metal *
[II] Grave Mixture NEW; 2 2/3' + 2'; spotted metal

- toeholes opened significantly

[8] Viola II. Man. common metal, t.c; box beards 13-17; softened
ca. 1890
[8] St'd. Diap'n. II Man. wood, t.c.; c#³-a³ open flues, common metal;
partially ca. 1890
[8] Unison Bass II. Man. 1-12 wood
[4] Flute II. Man. 1-5 zinc, then common metal, open cylindrical [4']
