

## GRAND ORGAN RECITAL

At the New Centenary M. E.  
Church Last Night.

ASSISTED BY MOZART QUARTET

A Great Audience Greatly Edified, as  
Will be Again the Case at the Dedi-  
catory Services To-morrow.

This spacious and beautiful new house of worship was packed with a perspiring but delighted audience last night, who greatly enjoyed the instrumentation of Prof. David D. Wood, organist of St. Stephen's Church, Philadelphia, and the singing of the Mozart Double Quartette, with H. E. Wilt accompanist, Prof. Powell G. Fithian aiding in the concourse of sweet sounds. The following program was most acceptably rendered :

Part One—Overture, "Favorite," Auber; "Remember Now Thy Creator," Mozart Quartette, Gould; "Largo and Minuet," Handel; "God is Love," Mozart Quartette, Powell; "Offertoire," (St. Cecelia,) in D, Batiste.

Part Two—"Lead, Kindly Light," Mozart Quartette, Gounod; Improvisation on Familiar Airs; "Annie Laurie," Mozart Quartette, arranged by A. Geibel; Overture to Wm. Tell, (by request,) Rossini; "Our God Stands Firm," Mozart Quartette, Weber.

The organ is remarkably fine in tone and powerful in compass, and will be a feature of the dedicatory service to-morrow under the masterly manipulation of Prof. R. C. Mason.
