

ABOUT OUR ORGAN

The Schantz Organ Company is American's oldest and largest pipe organ builder, and still under management of the founding family. Each Schantz Pipe Organ is a unique instrument crafted to serve the special requirements it is called to fulfill. Painstaking attention is given to every detail in all aspects of the design: physical layout, tonal composition, construction, assembly and testing, installation and tonal finishing.

The Schantz 2000 Pipe Organ at Cross of Christ includes the following:

- 3 manuals, Forty-Seven ranks
- Two Thousand Seven Hundred pipes in Four divisions
- Seventy-One Drawknobs
- Fifty-One Pistons
- Twenty-Four Toe Studs
- Sixteen Couplers
- Façade pipes made of zinc and tin
- Unseen pipes made of spotted metal/tin
- Flute pipes 60% lead and 40% tin
- Bass and pedal pipes are zinc
- Wood flutes and bourdons are poplar
- Trumpet pipes are made of copper

Schantz obtains its wood from the state of Virginia. The wood they use is "A" quality, whereas most furniture is "B" quality. The Schantz builders worked diligently with our contractor to make sure the solid cherry matched the cherry in our Sanctuary.

ABOUT OUR ORGANIST

Bart David Larive began studying piano at the age of seven years with teacher, Matilda Eidt. At the age of thirteen years, Bart attended The Detroit Conservatory of Music under the tutelage of Vanetta Doughty. Among Bart's varied musical endeavors are chapel pianist for Edsel Ford High School, and pianist/soloist on the local ABC TV show, "Auntie Dee." He has served as organist and/or choir director at four churches. In 1982 Bart, his wife, Jill, and sons, Keith and Kevin, came to Cross of Christ, where he now serves as Organist and Choir Director.
