

ORGAN FOR ZIEGEL CHURCH.

Historical Congregation Closes Contract With Allentown Dealer for Fine Estey Instrument.

Fred. F. Kramer, the popular music dealer of 544 Hamilton street, has just closed a contract for building a magnificent Estey pipe organ to be installed in the new Ziegel Church, Weisenburg township. The specifications indicate that this will be the finest organ of its size in this part of the country.

The instrument will be built entirely on the tubular pneumatic system, which represents the most approved method of pipe organ construction. It will also be supplied with individual wind chests, each set of pipes having its special chest, and each pipe its individual valve. This is the most satisfactory system known to the art of pipe organ building, as it prevents any possibility of "robbing" or "gasping" of the pipes so often noticed in organs where this method of construction is not followed. The instrument will have nearly 1000 pipes and will be provided with a fine variety of solo stops, including the Estey patent oboe, which is a metal flue pipe, without any reed, but of peculiar structure and voicing.

This magnificent instrument will be installed the latter part of April and opened with appropriate ceremonies.

Mr. Kramer is to be congratulated on securing this contract, as he has long represented the Estey organ in this section of the country, and this is only another evidence of the confidence of the people in the Estey Organ Co., as well as its local representative.
