

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, made this 9 day of February, A. D., 1937 by and between M. P. MOLLER INC., of Hagerstown, Maryland, party of the first part, and the FOURTH REFORMED CHURCH of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, by its authorized representatives as party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part agrees to rebuild the organ in said church damaged by fire, and which when completed shall be after and in accordance with the original specification, copy of which is attached hereto; and to re-install the said organ in the church complete and ready for use, every part in as good condition as new, and to guarantee the said organ and the work done thereon against defective materials or workmanship for a period of five (5) years from the date of installation.

The date of installation is figured as of the 25 day of May, A. D., 1937, or as soon thereafter as possible in the event of delay beyond control of either party hereto.

In the carrying out of this agreement, it is understood that the party of the first part shall remove the remaining parts of the said organ and the electric blower from the church, and return them to his factory, but that the party of the first part shall be permitted to use in the rebuilt organ, under this contract, the pipes and other parts of the present Great organ that are not seriously damaged and can be put in as good serviceable condition as new parts, but that the wind chest of the remaining Great organ shall be replaced by a new chest of the modern type now used by the said party of the first part, and which type will be used in the swell organ or division at the opposite side of the chancel.

An entirely new console is to be furnished, but the present blower, motor and generator may be used provided they can be put in first class condition, and all of the electric wiring in the organ to be new.

This proposition does not include furnishing of the grilles to enclose the organ spaces.

It is mutually understood and agreed that the party of the second part may have the privilege of having the organ examined immediately on completion in the church by a disinterested expert selected by the party of the second part, and if any of the conditions are found not to be in accord with this agreement, the party of the first part is to make corrections at his expense.

For and in consideration of the above, the said party of the second part agrees to pay to M. P. MOLLER INC., or order, the sum of _____

AS FOLLOWS: Cash on completion.

The party of the second part also agrees that the building will be in proper condition for the installation of the organ 3 weeks previous to date of completion: that they will allow, free from interruption, suitable convenience and opportunity for the installation in the building, provide such a condition of quiet as is necessary for the proper tone regulation and tuning of the instrument, and necessary light, heat and power.

The party of the second part also agrees to insure the organ or its parts against loss by fire, water, etc., as soon as the parts are placed in the building, for the benefit of the parties hereto, as their interests may appear.

When electric motor is included in specifications, party of the second part agrees to provide foundation and enclosures when necessary, to furnish and install all wind conductor between blower and organ; to do all wiring connected therewith; to install such lights as may be needed for the erection and future care of the organ, and do any necessary cutting of floors, partitions, or other parts of the building. In the event that automatic remote control motor starter, electrical conduits or other special equipment are required they are to be furnished by party of second part.

When organ chambers are so located that organ parts must be hoisted by skids, block and tackle or other mechanical means the necessary apparatus is to be furnished by party of second part.

It is mutually understood and agreed that this contract shall be binding after, but not before, acceptance at Hagerstown, Maryland by the party of the 1st part, and it is to be conclusively presumed that the conditional sale hereby made is made and consummated at said Hagerstown, Md, where said organ is to be constructed in the plant of the party of the first part.

It is also mutually understood and agreed that the organ, when completed and installed, will in every event be and deemed to be, and treated as personal property; and that the title and ownership of the organ shall be and remain in the party of the first part until the purchase price hereinbefore mentioned, together

WITH Any and all promissory notes given in respect thereof have been fully paid, with interest, after which the instrument shall become the property of the party of the second part; and it is further agreed that, until the completion of payment the organ shall be held by the party of the second part and/ or other owner or lessee of the premises in which the organ is contained, free and excluded from any lien, mortgage, pledge or other incumbrance, except such as shall be expressly subject and subordinate to the right and title of the party of the first part, as herein expressed.

It is mutually agreed that all verbal agreements and understandings are merged in this contract and the specifications attached hereto.
