

A NEW ORGAN.—A magnificent Organ, manufactured by Henry Knapp, Philadelphia, has recently been erected in the Congregational Church in Canandaigua. It is fourteen feet wide, six feet and two inches deep, and twenty feet high, containing twenty stops, two full sets of keys, a pedal bass with a double open diapason, two coupling stops and three composition pedals by which various combinations are formed without taking the hands from the keys. The erection of an instrument of this kind, reflects credit upon the musical taste of Canandaigua.—*Rock. Dem.*
