DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGAN.
This organ stands in chamber at left of Chancel, with case and display pipes fronting both Chancel and Auditorium. with Console on Auditorium side.
The case is of quartered red oak of design and finish appropriate to the church. council.

The display pipes are well grouped and finished in clear gold leaf, with shaded and benefied close in harmony with the wall and glass colors.

The Console is equipped with all modern and courenient appliances for easy control of the instrument by the player, the action being of the very best type of inholar pneumatic countertion, the touch of the keys being equal or better than that on the best pinn action. the totes of the expectation extonthe response being quies and fall, and
