**Memorandum of Agreement,**

**Witnesseth:** That the party of the first part hereby agrees to build an organ after and according to the annexed specifications and to plans to be hereafter submitted by party of the first part, and to erect it in... the above church  
at as early a date as the present conditions will permit.

2. The party of the first part agrees that the organ when completed shall be first class, free from defects in material or workmanship, and that the party of the second part may have it examined, immediately on completion, in the presence of a representative of the party of the first part, by a competent and disinterested expert, and if said examination shows that the organ does not conform with this agreement the party of the first part agrees to remedy all defects at its own expense.

3. The party of the first part guarantees the action and construction of the organ for a term of five years from date of completion and agrees to correct any defects in either material or workmanship that may be brought to its attention within that time, without cost to the party of the second part. This does not include tuning or ordinary care of the organ (or electric motors which are guaranteed by the manufacturers for one year).

4. Cabinet work (except as necessary to enclose the console), grilles, panel work, etc., are not included in this agreement.

5. In consideration of the above, the party of the second part agrees to pay to M. P. Moller, Inc., or its order, the sum of... EIGHT THOUSAND AND EIGHTY (\$8,080.00) DOLLARS

## AS FOLLOWS:

FIRST PAYMENT: 10 % or (\$808.00)  
on the signing of this agreement.

SECOND PAYMENT: 35 % or (\$2,828.00)

when the organ is ready for assembly at the factory, and the balance as follows: 25% or (\$2,020.00)  
when the organ has been built and installed, and the balance in one year, payable by equal quarterly notes bearing 6% interest.

6. The price mentioned in paragraph 5 is based on costs existing at the date of this agreement, and should be increased in case of material cost increases above their present levels before construction of the organ is started; the following provision on price adjustment applies: In any case of increase in labor or material costs up to 15% of the price specified in paragraph 5 the party of the second part agrees to pay the entire amount of said increase; in any case of increase in costs between 15% and 25% of the price specified in paragraph 5 the party of the second part agrees to pay an increase of 15% of said price and in any case of increase in costs of more than 25% of the price specified in paragraph 5 the party of the second part will, upon notice, promptly agree to pay the entire amount of such increase; on this agreement no change shall be made by either party hereto. No such increase in price shall be effective unless the party of the second part is notified in writing of the increase in price of the organ is started; in such increased price of any part the party of the second part agrees to pay the increase in price as provided in said paragraph 5; should such increase in price be less than the increase in price of the organ is started, the party of the second part will be entitled to a reduction in the price specified in paragraph 5 equivalent to the increase in said costs from the labor and materials used in constructing said organ.

The party of the second part agrees to pay any and all federal, state, and/or city excise, sales and/or use taxes, the said taxes to be paid according to law, in addition to the above price.

7. The party of the second part also agrees that the building will be in proper condition for the installation of the organ . . . . . weeks previous to the date of completion; that they will allow, free from interruption, suitable convenience and opportunity for the installation in the building, provide such a condition of quiet as is necessary for the proper tone regulation and tuning of the instrument, and necessary light, heat and power.

8. The party of the second part also agrees to insure the organ or its parts against loss by fire, water, etc as soon as the parts are placed in the building, for the benefit of the parties hereto, as their interests may appear.

9. When an electric motor is included in specifications, party of the second part agrees to provide foundation and enclosures when necessary, also to furnish and install all wind conductor between blower and organ; to do all wiring connected therewith; to install such lights as may be needed for the erection and future care of the organ, and do any necessary cutting of floors, partitions, or other parts of the building. In the event that automatic remote control motor starter, electrical conduits or other special equipment are required they are to be furnished by party of second part.

10. When organ chambers are so located that organ parts must be hoisted by skids, block and tackle or other mechanical means, the necessary apparatus is to be furnished by party of second part.

11. It is mutually understood and agreed that this contract shall be binding after, but not before, acceptance by the party of the first part at Hagerstown, Maryland, where said organ is to be constructed in the plant of the party of the first part.

12. It is also mutually understood and agreed that the organ, when completed and installed, will in every event be and be deemed to be, and be treated as personal property; and that the title and ownership of the

organ shall be and remain in the party of the first part until the purchase price hereinbefore mentioned, together with any and all promissory notes given in respect thereof have been fully paid, with interest, after which the instrument shall become the property of the party of the second part; and it is further agreed that, until the completion of payment the organ shall be held by the party of the second part and/or other owner or lessee of the premises in which the organ is contained, free and excluded from any lien, mortgage, pledge or other incumbrance, except such as shall be expressly subject and subordinate to the right and title of the party of the first part, as herein expressed.

13. it is mutually agreed that all verbal agreements and understandings are merged in this contract and the specifications attached hereto.

This made a very nice little organ and the pipes required considerable less work than most of the jobs I get out here; however, it was necessary to do some switching in locations of the front row of the Pedal Diapason pipes in order to get them go on the chests due to the large pipes in the back row being mitered. It is quite evident that these pipes were never placed back in the organ after the mitering had been done, to make sure that they would go alright. I realize that should not be necessary providing one can thoroughly depend on his measurements, but, if such is not the case then I would suggest that they be checked. It so happened that I had the same condition on the St. Anthony' Catholic organ a short while ago. There I was unable to swith the pipes around and it was necessary to miter two of them.

Dedication is being planned for sometime later in the summer and I will try to check over the organ before that time.

Guy Lumm, 9946 Mansfield, Detroit 27, Michigan, to be there upon the arrival of this truck in order to assist with the unloading and start the installation immediately thereafter.

We would appreciate if you would make arrangements with a tinner and an electrician so they will be available immediately after the installation of the organ has been started in order that they may proceed with the electrical work and the running of the conductor pipe, as our installation men are not licensed to handle high voltage lines, and as you know, our contract specifies that the church shall run the conductor pipe from the organ chamber proper to the blower.

Under the terms of our contract the organ is to be adequately insured for our benefit until we receive full cash settlement. We suggest that you furnish this insurance in the form of a specific policy running to us, but if you prefer to include the organ in your general insurance form it will be satisfactory to us for you to have your policies endorsed "Loss, if any, upon pipe organ payable to M. P. Moller, Inc., Hagerstown, Md., as its interest may appear," and send either the policies or proper certificates to us. Please note that the customary mortgagee clause used in insurance policies is not applicable in our case as we are not a mortgagee but the holder of legal title to the organ. We trust that you will find it convenient to forward the insurance papers to us as soon as the organ is unloaded in the building.



Enclosed please find contract and check in the amount of \$808.00 covering down payment on organ for subject church. Plans of organ space and questionnaire are also being enclosed. Wood sample is being forwarded under separate cover.

This is the job that I <sup>talked</sup> about to you sometime ago. Schantz's price for the same specification was \$1400. under our price. Schantz also offered a two manual duplexed organ with 90 some more pipes than our specifications have, for \$7100. I thought you might be interested in our competitor's prices.

Although, not in the specifications, you will note the suggestions I have made on the questionnaire regarding the tone and scales of the stops. I would like the Gamba to be more Viole than Gamba and the 16' pedal Diapason should be of a small scale toward a Violone. As you already know the Trumpets with the exception of Trinity Lutheran, Port Huron and St. Catherine's here in Detroit, have been considerably on the loud side and I have had several criticisms along that line. Therefore, I would suggest a 3-1/2 scale Trumpet for this job, particularly, since this is a small church with hard plastered walls and bare floor except in aisle and chancel.

I hope that these suggestions will be received in a constructive manner and that they will get some consideration.




