

Headlee Plans Organ Recital

Will O. Headlee, son of Mrs. J. C. Headlee of Asheville, will be heard in an organ recital at the Union Hour Sunday at 7:30 p. m. in the Presbyterian Church.

Headlee, at the age of 13, became organist of First Congregational Church here, remaining for five years until he entered the University of North Carolina in 1948. He was holder of the Kay Kyser scholarship in music, which his brother, Jim Headlee, held after him.

While at Chapel Hill he was organist of the Presbyterian Church and during his senior year taught organ.

Headlee, who studied with the late Hobart Whitman, began his early studies with Mrs. J. W. Cook.

During the recital Sunday an offering will be taken towards the rose window which will be placed in the church in memory of Whitman, who was organist at the First Presbyterian Church for several years.
