

Cyrus H. K. Curtis Will Give \$30,000 Organ To Bowdoin

Contract With Austin Or- gan Company of This City Is Announced

Gift of a \$30,000 organ for the chapel of Bowdoin College at Brunswick, Me., by Cyrus H. K. Curtis of Philadelphia has just been disclosed through a contract with the Austin Organ Company of this city. Work on the organ has commenced at the factory and completion in time for installation so that it may be used in connection with the commencement exercises in June is specified. The organ will be encased in walnut and will be a full size instrument with all modern attachments.

Mr. Curtis who is a native of Maine, thus adds to his gifts to Bowdoin. A swimming pool was one of his other gifts.

Mr. Curtis is a patron of music and founded the Curtis School of Music in Philadelphia.

The Austin Organ Company has been awarded the contract for the building and installation of the organ for the new Allyn Theater. The company also has a contract for the installation of an addition to its organ in the city hall at Portland, Me.
