The Schantz Organ AT CUSTER ROAD UMC

he pipe organ at Custer Road United Methodist Church is among the largest, most complex instruments built by Schantz Organ Company in its 133-year history. The instrument is actually a double organ. The Chancel Organ comprises four manual and pedal divisions with 75 ranks of pipes. The Gallery Organ, located in the rear gallery,

contains two manual and pedal divisions with 17 ranks of pipes. The entire organ is playable from the main Chancel console. The two-manual Gallery console plays the Gallery Organ and can also control the entire organ through the use of "blind" general pistons copied from the front console.

The supporting structure of the instrument and much of the mechanism (windchests) is made of poplar wood. The majority of the metal pipe work is tin-lead alloy, but the larger pipes are made of zinc, a stronger, yet lighter metal than tin

and lead. The Trompette en Chamade that embellishes the front painted maple casework is polished copper.

> The resources of the instrument are distributed in four locations

> > in the renovated sanctuary. The Great and Swell divisions of the Chancel Organ are installed in chambers immediately behind the Chancel case. These chambers were built especially for the installation of this new instrument. The Choir, Solo, Pedal 32' Ophicleide and 16' Bourdon are housed in the chambers on either side of the Chancel. The Gallery Organ is housed in its cases at the rear of the back gallery. With organ pipes in these various locations, the instrument is able to produce the organ's equivalent of a "surround sound" effect. With 71 stops and a total of 92 ranks of pipes totaling 5,284 pipes, the instrument contains a variety of organ tones ranging from the softest whisper of sound to the noble Tuba Mirabilis and the declamatory Trompette en Chamade, which is installed on the Chancel case, adding visual interest to the organ's design.

Each Schantz organ is a custom designed instrument built to fit the physical space and the musical needs of each unique project. Literally no two instruments are alike. As such, numerous hours are necessary for the construction of each new organ. The Custer Road UMC instrument required more than 25,000 hours of labor for the design, construction, installation, and tonal finishing.




