Beautiful Organ.—One of the most beautiful parlor organs of the present day has just been completed at the organ factory of Mr. Berger, Frederick street, per order of Robert A. Taylor, Esq. The music is enclosed in a solid rosewood case, measuring ten feet in height, six feet wide, and three feet deep, which has been designed and finished in the most elegant style of workmanship, constituting it a beautiful ornament. The various stops comprise a variety of sweet tones, and are voiced with great accuracy. The performance of the instrument has invited and received the most favorable opinion of several accomplished organists.
