

## *Dr. Donald W. Williams*

**D**r. Williams, consultant and guest organist, has been the organist-choirmaster of Zion Lutheran Church in Ann Arbor since September, 1963. In addition to directing Zion's active music program, he is also a member of the organ faculty of Concordia College, has served as guest lecturer and recitalist at the Interlochen Arts Academy and National Music Camp, and has been a visiting faculty member of the University of Michigan and Eastern Michigan University.

A graduate of Peabody College, Nashville, and the



University of Michigan, Dr. Williams has studied with the late Joseph T. Ragan, Scott Withrow, Peter Fyfe and Marilyn Mason. At Peabody, he was named the outstanding performer in the Senior Class of 1961. More recent honors have included the prestigious "Palmer Christian Award" from the University of Michigan in recognition of outstanding accomplishments in teaching, performing and choral conducting.

As a recitalist, Dr. Williams is very active performing extensively in the United States, Canada and Europe. He was a recitalist for the National Convention of the American Guild of Organists in Detroit. Critics and concertgoers alike have praised Dr. Williams' creative programming, his command of the organ and his obvious professionalism.

## *Casavant Frères Limitée*

---

**F**rom 1837 until his retirement in 1866, Joseph Casavant produced 17 pipe organs in his St. Hyacinthe shop for churches and seminaries in Canada. In 1875, his sons, Claver and Samuel, traveled to Paris where they spent some time with the famed French organ builder Cavaille-Coll. After traveling widely throughout Europe visiting builders

and notable organs, they returned to St. Hyacinthe in 1879 to establish themselves as Casavant Frères on the site where the present workshop stands. The instrument which firmly established their reputation as organ builders of international repute was built in 1891 for the church of Notre Dame in Montreal. This organ of four manuals and 82 stops is still in use today. The Christ Our Savior Organ is the 3,712th instrument built by Casavant Frères.
