

LYNWOOD FARNAM TO GIVE ORGAN RECITAL TODAY

Lynwood Farnam, one of the greatest of American organists, will be heard in recital at 4 o'clock this afternoon at the United Hebrew Temple organ at 225 South Skinker road. The recital, sponsored by the Kilgen Organ Company, is primarily for the benefit of university and high school students of St. Louis, but will be open to the public.

Farnam was organist and choir-master at Christ Church Cathedral here for five years. He is now organist at the Church of the Holy Communion, New York. His program is:
