NOTE: In order to build the organ now, it will be necessary for the church to turn in 8 sets of metal pipes from the present organ as salvage, and 1 set of metal pipes will be furnished from inventory in the plant (reconditioned pipes). The two sets of wooden pipes to be new. All of the other parts of the organ to be new, with the exception of the present case and display pipes.
