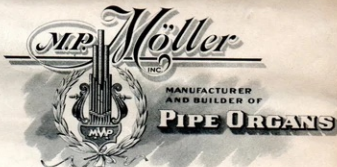

Dear Sir:

Your letter to the Factory relative to a used organ, has been forwarded to this office for attention. Enclosed is a specification of a Farrand & Votey used organ, which is still in the First Church of God at Harrisburg, Pa. The organ will be available about Easter, at the time we install the new Moller Organ. The organ occupies a space on the floor, 6' by 14' and is at present about 16' high, which can be reduced, if necessary, to 15'. It has a handsome quarter-oak case with overhang and is very attractive. Enclosed you will also find a photograph showing the front of the organ.

The action is tubular-pneumatic to the wind chest with mechanical couplers. You will note from the photograph that at present the console is at the end, but could be easily moved to the center of front.

We will sell this organ installed complete for \$2,250.00. This includes electric motor, blower and installation. This is a bargain, and such an organ new would cost about \$6,000.00. The pipe work and everything excepting the valves is as good as new, and the valves would be recovered, and we would put the organ in first class condition.

We are advertizing the organ, and it will be sold to the first one accepting the proposition, so if this interests you, please let us hear from you at once. We would also thank you to return the photograph, if you decide not to buy the organ.
