Church dates two concerts

Two inaugural concerts Sunday will mark the completion of the installation of a new mechanical action Aeolian-Skinner Organ in the Cox Chapel of Highland Park United Methodist Church.

The identical concerts are set for 3:15 and 8:15 p.m. All three of the church organists, Phil Baker, John Erickson and Mrs. Barbara Klump, will participate in each of the programs.

The contract was signed with the Aeolian-Skinner Organ Co. in June, 1970, for this instrument to be built under the supervision of Robert L. Sipe, who has personally installed and voiced the instrument.

The organ has 24 stops with 33 ranks of pipes. The organ casework is of oak with an attached keydesk of rosewood. The stop action is electric and features a solid state capture combination action system.
