This agreement made this 12th day of April 1909. M. F. Moller, party of the first part and First Presbyterian Church, Horseneads, N. Y. party of the second part, witnesseth.

The party of the first part does hereby agree to build an organ complete and ready for use on or before the 1st day of July 1909 or as soon thereafter.

The party of the first part further agrees for the term of three years to remedy all defects therein resulting from the use of improper material or inferior workmanship.

The party of the second part agrees to pay to M. F. Moller or his order, the sum of \$1500.00 at completion (one half the cost of this organ or \$900.00 will be paid by Mr. Andrew Carnegie, by whom the allowance has been granted).
