All old pipes are to be re-voiced so as to get the best possible results.

Case and Pipe Front will remain as it is unless some change is decided upon in arrangement of display pipes.

Display pipes to be covered with Gold Leaf.

-: POWER :-

An Electric Blower to be installed of sufficient power to meet all legitimate demands upon it.

All wiring and preparing of the Organ Chambers to be done by the purchaser.

THIS AGREEMENT

Made this ..... day of 13th April ..... A. D., 1915 between  
HILLGREEN, LANE & COMPANY, OF ALLIANCE, OHIO, of the first part, and  
..... Mrs. L. E. Stearns of Cincinnati, Ohio .....  
..... of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the party of the first part HEREBY AGREES to build an  
Organ according to the specifications annexed, and to erect the same in the .....  
..... residence of Mrs. L. E. Stearns .....  
having it completed and ready for use on or about the .... 15 ... day of September 1915.

Should said Organ, upon examination by a competent and disinterested expert selected by second party, be found not to accord with the specifications and terms of this agreement, said first party agrees, at its own cost and expense, to at once make good any defect, or failing in this, to remove said Organ from the building, and the party of the second part shall no longer be held by the terms of this agreement.

And said first party further agrees, at its own cost and expense, for the term of three years next after the completion of said Organ, to remedy any and all defects therein, resulting from the use of improper materials or from inferior workmanship.

And the second party hereby agrees to pay to HILLGREEN, LANE & CO., or to their order, the sum of ..... Sixty-Seven Hundred Dollars .....

payable upon acceptance of Organ as follows:

And the party of the second part further agrees, that said building and Organ Chamber shall be in readiness for the erection, tuning and regulating of said Organ, including the conveniences of light, heat and power, and subject to the possession of representatives of the party of the first part for a period .. 30 ... days next previous to specified time for completion of Organ.

And the party of the second part further agrees to have Organ examined immediately on completion, so that the party of the first part, or its representatives, shall not suffer delay.

And the party of the second part further agrees to assume all risk of damage to said Organ, or parts thereof, when placed inside the building it is to occupy; and to receive the Organ upon its arrival, cart it to the building and pay the freight thereon, said freight and cartage to be deducted from the price of the Organ, and such reception and care not to be construed as an acceptance of said Organ.
