

THE LUTHERAN CHURCH AT GERMAN-TOWN.—This church, of which the Rev. L. E. Albert is pastor, has just had completed a new and beautiful organ, comprising some twenty-eight registers or draw stops, two banks of keys, and pedal bass. We were present at a private trial of the instrument on Wednesday evening last, when several organists from the city performed thereon, and displayed its varied parts. It consists of a great, swell, and pedal organ; and reflects great credit upon the builder, Mr. Samuel Bohler, of Reading, Pa. The reed stops, "trumpet" and "hautboy" are particularly fine, the diapasons excellent, and the dulcissima, together with the melodia flute, each of a superior character. As a whole, the organ is a first-class instrument, and the congregation may well congratulate themselves upon this acquisition and aid to the services of the church.—*Phil. Evening Bulletin.*
