

ARTICLES OF AN AGREEMENT, made this *Third*  
day of July 1915, by and between THE ERNEST M. SKINNER COMPANY,  
Organ Builder, of Boston, Massachusetts, party of the first  
part and *The First Congregational Church* *J. H. Doyle Chairman*  
*Frank K. Chapin Sec*  
party of the second part.

For and in consideration of the sum of FIFTEEN  
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00) together with old organ now in  
storage, to be paid by the party of the second part to the  
party of the first part, the said party of the first part  
agrees to build an organ, according to the annexed specifications,  
in a most thorough and artistic manner, and install it in the  
FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH, Toledo, Ohio, complete in every  
detail and fully warranted, on or before December 15, 1915.

The party of the second part agrees that during the  
installation of the said organ they will keep said church at  
such reasonable temperature as may be required by the party  
of the first part; that they will provide and allow the use  
of the electric current for tuning and lighting; that they  
will afford such a condition of quiet within the building as  
may be needful for the proper tone regulation and tuning of  
the instrument, and that they will allow suitable convenience  
and opportunity for the installation and completion of the  
organ in the said building, free from unreasonable interruption.

The party of the second part agrees to insure the  
organ as soon as it or its parts shall have been deposited  
in the building, for the benefit of the parties hereunto, as  
their interests may appear.

The party of the second part further agrees to pay  
to the party of the first part, the sum of fifteen thousand  
dollars (\$15,000.00) as follows:-

*Eight Thousand (\$8000.00)*

~~upon the delivery of the organ at the~~  
building, ~~exclusive of the smaller pipes;~~ *Four Thousand (\$4000.00)*  
completion and acceptance of said organ. *the balance (\$3000.00)*  
*Three Thousand, sixty days after acceptance and completion.*  
It is agreed that the title to the organ shall belong  
to the party of the first part until the contract price, as  
heretofore stated, has been fully paid, with interest upon  
any deferred payments, at the rate of six per cent per annum,  
and that upon such payment the organ shall become the property  
of the party of the second part.

All basses of the larger winded stops on separate chests.

No stopped basses on normally open stops.

All stops extend throughout the compass, except the Unda Maris.

The action to be electro pneumatic.

Suitable electric blowing machinery to be provided, exclusive of wiring.

No masons' or builders' work included in this contract (any possible structural alterations in the building.)

Casework to be included of approved design -- cost not to exceed 8% of the total cost of the organ.

PRICE: - \$15,000.00 together with old organ now in storage.

- 2' x 3' 1-Res — 3. One three stop chest to include 4' Octave, *✓ 1 for Stop Act* *7 1/2" Pressure*  
8' Flute and 4' Flute;
- 8' Harmonic (Wind) *7 1/2" Pressure*  
4' " (Com)  
4' Oct 57
4. Vox Humana for Swell, *✓ 1 for Stop Act*
- ✓ 5. Chimes - five new bells G to B (?) lower register;
- ✓ 6. New Chime action - 25 notes; — *main wind 11 3/4" } Present  
Echo Chest on 6" } chimes on  
main wind*
- ✓ 7. Knob with contact and switch for Pedal Chimes; *✓ 1 for Stop Act*
- ✓ 8. New Echo swell shoe.
