## Memorandum of Agreement.

Contract made and entered into this 14th day of February 1905  
by and between Henry Pilcher's Sons, Organ Builders, of Louisville, Ky., party of the  
first part, and The First Presbyterian Church, Waco, Texas,  
party of the second part, witnesseth:

The party of the first part shall build an organ of the best materials and in the  
most thorough and workmanlike manner, according to the annexed specifications and  
details of construction marked No. 10- and design to be hereafter  
approved by the party of the second part, setting up the same complete and ready for  
use, warranted first-class in all respects, in the afore named Church  
on or about  
the middle of May 1905.

The party of the second part, in full consideration for the above, shall pay unto the  
party of the first part upon their fulfilment of this agreement, the sum of Seventeen-  
hundred and fifty (1750) dollars in New York or New Orleans  
Exchange.

The party of the second part is to prepare a suitable place for the organ, before the  
time specified for its delivery, and is to give exclusive use of the church to the party of  
the first part for ten working days immediately following its arrival at  
the church for the purpose of erecting and tuning the instrument.

All risk of damage to the organ or parts thereof resulting from fire or water, shall  
be incurred by the party of the second part, after the organ or parts thereof shall have  
been deposited in the building designated, and insurance covering any such loss is to  
be immediately placed by the party of the second part, payable to the party of the  
first part as their interest may appear.

The work to be fully warranted by the party of the first part, against any and all  
defects arising from the use of improper materials, or inferior workmanship, for the  
space of five years; and any such brought to their notice within that time to be reme-  
died without charge.
