

## THE ORGAN

The organ in The First Presbyterian Church of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, was built in 1947 by the Aeolian-Skinner Company of Boston. The instrument contains between 4,000 and 5,000 pipes and has 75 ranks covering a wide tonal range. In building this magnificent instrument, the builders sought to incorporate the finest features of both the classic and romantic trends of contemporary organ design. It is an all-purpose organ, and hence it is possible for this instrument to reproduce with fidelity organ literature of many musical periods and schools. The late G. Donald Harrison, president and technical director of the Aeolian-Skinner Co. designed the organ. As every organist knows, Mr. Harrison was one of the foremost organ authorities of the recent past, and designed many of the greatest organs in America. According to the builders, this instrument ranked among the finest church and concert organs in the East. It has been highly praised by many organists and organ authorities who have visited the instrument.

A brilliant opening recital was played on the instrument in September, 1947, by Mr. E. Power Biggs. Since that time the recital series have included performances by many of the outstanding names in the organ world. Mr. Reginald Lunt has been the staff organist since October, 1948.
