NEW PIPE ORGAN OF PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ARRIVED

The handsome new organ of the Presbyterian Church here has arrived and is now being installed in the beautiful new church building on Grenshaw Avenue. Mr. A. H. Toney of North Tarrytown, New York, is here installing the organ.

This organ cost something like \$20,000 including installation expenses and was selected by C. W. Weatherford and Mrs. Alston Maxwell after a trip north during which they inspected numerous organs in churches and theatres. They were accompanied on this trip by a committee from the Methodist Church also, composed of Mrs. Julian Perkins, Mrs. W. H. Raiford, and C. E. Boykin.

The Presbyterian Church is now completed except for the lighting fixtures and windows, there having been some delay in securing these.

The first services are expected to be held in the new church on the night of the 9th of April, or on the 23rd, most probably the latter date, it was announced today.
