The Furchaser to prepare the space for the reception of the Moller Organ out necessary openings through floors, ceilings and partitions, suply and install the electrical connections to the power plant and the starting switch at the console, including "remote control" starter, if same is required (and to supply and install conduit for the organ and console -- specifications to be furnished by the Organ Company. (The Revised rules adopted by the Electrical Operated Organs committee of the National Board of Fire Underwriters state explicitly: "Conduit may be used but is not required.")

The Purchaser is also to supply and the necessary heat, light, cleanliness and required quiet for erecting, tuning and regulating instrument.

## IMPORTANT SPECIAL AGREEMENT

- No. 1 This organ is to be divided into Accompaniment and Solo in the following manner: The organ is to be in one complete Swell Box with double sets of shutters, one protecting certain stops and the other all of the stops so that each section may be operated individually with reversible piston & indicator light, so that all shutters may operate together.
- No. 2 The entire Organ is to be on the Crescendo Pedal
- No. 3 The purpose of this organ is that it may be used for practice purposes by both the theatre organists and for church concert playing. It is necessary that when using the Crescendo for theatre work all stops and unifications must register, whereas using the organ for church and concert work certain of the unifications must mt be on the registration of the Crescendo Pedal. Therefore pistons must be on the console whereby the pressing of same will remove the theatre element of the organ electrically from the crescendo and stop action, regardless of position of controls. To be on and off pistons with light indicator to burn when theatre stops disconnected.
- No. 4 The instrument will be in a room approximately 14 feet in width and 24 feet in depth. It will be necessary therefore that the voicing of the organ be of such character that while all the characteristics of each individual rank of pipes be true, the general ensemble of the organ must be unusually soft and improper tone results KKAKK for the room itself.
- Mo. 5 The console is to be the regular theatre type M. P. Moller circular console, which permits the changing of combinations from the organists bench in the same manner that they are changed in their church organs.

The space which organ will speak into will be approximately 12'  $\times$  19' so voicing should be accordingly.

As to the Voicing, the Diaphone - Tuba register will have to be voiced with special attention to the blending of the two tones. The Orchestral Oboe I wish very fine and reedy so it will blend with the Vox Humana and the strings in full stringy effect.

Stops referred to in Paragraph three as the theatre element includes stops #1-2-5-6-7-8-14-16-20-21-22-25-31-36-37-38-39-40-41-42-43-44-45-51-52-53-54-55-56-57-70-71 & 72.

The Riser board from the keys of the Solo Manual to the curved stop key board to start approximately  $l\frac{1}{2}$  inches back from the rear of the sharp keys of the Solo Manual.

Expression Pedal Levers to be placed in the gap between second D sharp and F sharp of the Pedal Board. Organ bench to be full length of the console same as standard Church Bench, equipped with spring back and upholstered sheet. Console to be regular theatre circular type with lights on Music Rack & Pedal.
