

**A NEW ORGAN.**

**Soon to be Placed in the Church of St.  
Charles Borromeo.**

The grand organ destined for the Church of St. Charles Borromeo, on Sidney place, Rev. Father Friel, pastor, the construction of which was commenced in June last, is now approaching completion. It is expected to be in position by the early part of next month, and the first time it is played will be made the occasion of a musical celebration or concert, at which an elaborate programme will be presented. The instrument is one of the finest in the country, and was built by Odell Brothers, who have recently furnished the organs for Trinity Chapel, St. Bartholomew's and St. Patrick's Cathedral, in New York. The great organ, choir organ, small organ and pedal organs are remarkably brilliant, soft and powerful. Beside these organs, which have the usual pressure of wind (3 1/4 inches), there is a wind chest with ten inches pressure, worked by tubular pneumatic action. This plays a tuba cornet of fifty-eight pipes, and is heard above the other stops. Mr. A. J. Davis is the organist of the church.
