

THIS AGREEMENT made this 13th. day of May, 1924 by and between HILLGREEN, LANE & COMPANY, OF ALLIANCE, OHIO, party of the first part, and C. H. BRICK OF DALLAS, TEXAS, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part hereby agrees to make and furnish the following Organ material and parts, and have them ready to ship about August 1, 1924:

One Chest complete for 2 Stops with Drawstop Box and Pipes as follows: 8' Viol d'Orchestre, 73 Pipes; bass to be mitred to 6'; 8' Viol Celeste, 61 Pipes; Swell Box front frame with Shades and Swell Engine.

One Chest for 2 Stops with Drawstop Box and Pipes as follows: 8' ~~Second~~ <sup>First (Very Loud)</sup> Diapason, 61 Pipes; 8' Cello, 61 Pipes.

One Chest for 2 Stops with Drawstop Box and Pipes as follows: 8' Quintadena, 73 Pipes; 8' Unda Maris, 61 Pipes.

One Chest for 6 Stops with Drawstop Box and Pipes as follows: 8' Second Diapason, 61 Pipes; 8' Doppel Flute, 61 Pipes; 4' Rohr Flute, 61 Pipes; 8' Salicional, 61 Pipes; 8' Salicional Celeste, 49 Pipes; 8' Vox Humana, 61 Notes (lower 12 Pipes only); Swell Box front frame with Shades and Swell Engine.

16' Pedal Bourdon, Chest and Pipes, 30 Notes.

16' Violon, Chest and Pipes, 12 Notes only, Wood or Metal.

One Pedal Chest for 36 Pipes, including Pipes as follows: 8' Gross Flute Augmented with 16' Open top octave 12 Pipes; 8' Pedal Dolce Augmented with 16' Pedal Bourdon, top octave 12 Pipes; 4' Pedal Cello Augmented with 8' Cello, top octave 12 Pipes.

One 30-Note Pedal Relay for 3 Stops as follows: 32' Resultant, 16' Bourdon, 16' Violon.

Cables on Swell, Great and Choir Chests to be 12 ft. long. Cable on other Chests to be about 4 ft. long.

One set of 8' Trumpet Pipes, 44 Pipes, from second F.

Antiphonal Chest to be mounted on building frame here, and Wind Trunks to be fitted connecting Reservoir and Chest. Curtain Valve Box to be furnished.

All Pipes to be voiced on 4" wind pressure, A-~~440~~ <sup>440</sup> pitch.

It is understood that said work is to be of first-class material and workmanship, and that it shall be properly boxed and crated and delivered on board car at Alliance, Ohio.

It is further agreed that the party of the second part shall pay to HILLGREEN, LANE & CO. or to their order the sum of Twenty Seven Hundred Thirty Six Dollars (\$2736.00) for the above material F.O.B. Alliance, and payable as follows:

All deferred payments to bear 6% interest.
