The organ was originally built by the Hook and Hastings Organ Company in 1923. This recital marks the opening of the instrument after a modernization by the Schantz Organ Company which included the replacement and addition of several ranks of pipes, new console, cleaning, revoicing, and new blower. Installation was made by R. R. Perry and A. E. Lunsford of the Schantz company.
