

### New Pipe Organ.

Mr. William King, a builder of fifty years experience, and the representative of Hook-Hasting Co., Boston, has been engaged during the last two weeks in setting up the new pipe organ at the Presbyterian church. It is a beautiful instrument both in tone and workmanship. The front is of quarter sawed white oak and the show pipes are decorated in light green with white and gold trimmings. A Ross water motor furnishes the power. Provision has been made for the entire cost of the organ—\$2,150.

8 ft. Aeoline, Metal, 61 pipes.  
4 ft. Flute Harmonique, Metal, 61 pipes.  
8 ft. Oboe (and Bassoon), Metal, 61 pipes.
