

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, made this 3d. day of June 1927,
by and between HILLGREEN, LANE & COMPANY, of ALLIANCE, OHIO, party of the first part,
and Morrison Amusement Co. party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: The party of the first part, in consideration of the agreements hereinafter named, to be made
by the party of the second part, hereby agrees to build, install and sell to the party of the second part a

3-Manual Pipe Organ, according
to the specifications annexed, said Organ to be erected complete and ready for use in

Morrison Theatre on or about the 1st. day of Aug. 1927
subject, however, to delays from causes properly recognized as beyond the control of the party of the first part.

Should said Organ, after completion, and upon examination by a competent and disinterested expert employed
by the party of the second part, be found not to accord with specifications and terms of these agreements, said
party of the first part agrees, at its own cost and expense, to at once make good any deficiency, or failing in this,
to remove said Organ from the building, and refund the payments advanced by the party of the second part,
who shall no longer be held by the terms of these agreements.

The party of the first part further agrees, at its own cost and expense, for the term of one year after the comple-
tion of said Organ, to remedy any and all defects that may develop therein, this undertaking, however, not in-
cluding tuning nor such care of the instrument as is necessary to insure its normal preservation.

And the party of the second part, in consideration of the agreements herein of the party of the first part,
hereby requests the party of the first part to install said Organ, and agrees to purchase the same, paying there-
for the sum of Sixty Eight Hundred Dollars (\$6800.00)

as follows:

- (1.) Upon the signing of this agreement, the sum of \$ 500.00
- (2.) When the chief component parts of said Organ are constructed and assembled in the Factory of the party
of the first part, the sum of \$ _____
- (3.) Upon completion of the instrument in accordance with the agreements herein, the balance of said contract
price, namely, the sum of \$ 1000.00 and the balance of \$5300.00 covered
by 29 notes of \$175.00 and one for \$225.00, maturing
monthly and bearing 6% interest.

It is further agreed by the party of the second part that said building and Organ Chambers shall be in readiness
for the erection, tuning and regulating of said Organ, including the conveniences of light, heat and power and sub-
ject to the possession of representatives of the party of the first part for the period of 10 days
next, previous to the specified time for completion of the Organ, and that the party of the second part will have
the Organ examined immediately upon its completion and in the presence of a representative of the party of the
first part.

And the party of the second part further agrees, at its own expense to provide the necessary plumbing and
electric wiring, (including switches and fixtures) furnish the required wind Conduits from Blower to Organ, and
assume the expense of the cutting of such parts of the building, as may be necessary for the proper installation of
the Organ.

And the party of the second part further agrees to assume all risks of damage to said Organ, or parts thereof,
when placed inside the building it is to occupy; to receive the Organ upon its arrival, cart it to the building, and
pay the freights thereon, said freights and cartage to be deducted from the price of the Organ, and such reception
and care not to be construed as an acceptance of said Organ. It is also agreed that the party of the second part
shall place upon the instrument, in some reliable Company, adequate insurance for the benefit of the parties hereto,
as their respective interests may appear.

It is mutually agreed that in the event of a note or notes being given for any balance of said contract price, the
title to and ownership of said Organ shall be and remain in the party of the first part until such note or notes,
with accrued interest, shall be paid in full, and in default of payment of any such note or notes, with interest,
then all the sum represented by said note or notes, and interests, shall become due and payable, and the party of
the first part is hereby authorized at their option to take possession of said instrument without legal process, and all
payment heretofore made shall apply as rental for use of said Organ.

It is further agreed that the terms of this agreement shall apply to and bind the heirs, executors, administrators,
successors, and assigns of the respective parties.

Manual Key-board inclined. Convenient access to Key-contacts. Pedal Key-board concave and radiating. (American Guild of Organist's Pattern) unless otherwise specified.

Speaking Stops and Couplers operated by.....

Combinations adjustable at Key-desk, visibly affecting the stops, and operated by pistons located beneath the respective manuals. Pedals combinations operated either by toe-pistons or foot-levers.

Pitch, Philharmonic-440-A. 532. 3-C. (unless otherwise specified.)

A suitable Electric Blower and Motor of ample capacity to be furnished by the Organ Builders. Wiring of Motor (including switches and fixtures) conduits for Organ cables, and also galvanized iron wind-conduits between Blower and Organ to be supplied by the purchaser under the supervision of representatives of said Organ Builders. Suitable chambers or other provision for the housing of the Organ to be prepared by purchaser. A Low-Volt Generator will also be supplied by the Organ Builder to provide current for the Action.
