### Arthur Poister to Give Concert at Down- town Church

A varied program of organ numbers will be presented at 8:15 o'clock this evening in the First Presbyterian church by Arthur Poister, concert organist and former director of music in Central high school. His program will include one of his own compositions.

Classical composers are represented by Bach and Handel, the French school by Cesar Franck, modern French and German by Max Reger, Sigfrid Karg-Elert and Wider, with contemporary Americans represented by Joseph Clokey and Mr. Poister.
