ON NEW ECHO ORGAN

"Class No. 6," of the First Baptist Church Bible-school, Charles A. Reynolds, teacher, will give a vocal and instrumental concert and organ recital in the church, Fourth street, below Market, on Thursday evening next, 28th inst., which promises to be one of the finest entertainments ever given in that church. Prof. Charles H. Wood, organist of the church, will direct the music. The admission will be by silver offering and the proceeds will go into the class treasury.
