

CHURCH CELEBRATES

Sixty-first Anniversary of Baptist Church. New Pipe Organ Paid for. Sunday School Rally.

On last Sunday, the First Baptist Church, of Bristol celebrated its sixty-first anniversary. There were some very unique features in connection with the services; one of the original members of the church was present at both the morning and evening services, and the new pipe organ was used for the first time in religious worship.

Mr. Bunting and a special choir composed of the church choir and some friends outside of the church, who kindly assisted, gave choice selections at both morning, afternoon, and evening services. Miss Heiss, who has had charge of this organ for a number of years at the East Baptist Church, Philadelphia, from whom the organ was secured, presided; and G. M. Sinkler, who pumped it at the East Church came from Philadelphia purposely that he might assist on this occasion.

At the morning service Mr. Johnston presented to the trustees of the church the receipts for the payment of the organ installed; the money having been furnished by friends of Mr. Johnston and the church, but who are not members, some of them not being residents of Bristol, but all of them being in sympathy with the work.
