CONSOLE LIGHTS:-

The Contractor shall furnish and install and connect to the lighting circuit two lights, each complete with metal shade, and pull-chain lamp socket. They shall be conveniently located, one for illuminating the music rack and the manuals and stops, and the other for illuminating the pedals. The light over the music rack shall accommodate a tubular lamp. The shades and sockets shall be finished in dull brass.

PLAYER:-

The player shall be arranged for entire automatic playing, thereby controlling the stops, tempo, expression, etc; also for semi-automatic playing allowing the performer the control of the stops, tempo, expression, etc.

ACTION:-

The Action shall be electro-pneumatic throughout, with a separate magnet and pneumatic for each pipe to insure promptness of speech. Face boards shall be of hardwood such as mahogany or cherry.

CHESTS AND RESERVOIRS:-

The Chests and Reservoirs shall be of carefully selected lumber and at least two layers of selected pneumatic leather, and shall be of ample capacity.

SWELL SHADES:-

Swell shades shall be constructed of selected lumber with approved ball-bearings, and shall be arranged for graduation without audible stops in crescendo.

CABLES, MAGNETS, CONTACTS:-

All cables and magnets shall be efficiently insulated and protected, and shall be of the necessary size and capacity. All organ-action contacts shall be of silver and shall be self-cleaning.

BLOWER AND GENERATOR:-

Blower shall be a electric rotary blower, of the required capacity for the organ, and shall be complete with the necessary controls. The Blower shall be mounted on an insulated framework, securely bolted to the building structure in approved manner, to prevent noise and vibration.

INSTALLATIONS AND WIRING:-

The Contractor shall furnish and install all of the items specified or needed for the complete operation of the organ equipment, and shall make all connections between the various parts and to the electric service and other outlets already provided. Any additional wiring for the apparatus installed shall be furnished and install by the Contractor in an approved manner.

CUTTING AND DRILLING:-

The Contractor shall do all the cutting and drilling of his work and of any and all existing work of every nature necessary or required to properly attach and secure his work in place or to otherwise properly install and complete his work, and shall repair, restore or replace all existing work so cut, and leave building without the consent of the Architect.
