Dear Sirs:

Attached are sketches of the chamber and chest layout.

It seems to be necessary to place the Principal and Hohlflote up above the relay with sufficient space beneath to get under it and over to the walk board of the main chest - thus to the bottom of this chest 81.

You can wind and build these chests as you wish withint the limits of the area to be used. I suggest the resevoir for this work be in the swell since the 8" high pressure duct passes from the swell chamber to the Great just under the sepearating door.

The wind pressure at the relay measured is 7" and the wind pressure on the great 12th low C is 4 5/8". The swell Trumpet wind which would be the same for the Pomposa is 4 and 3/4".

Specification of the present organ, a two manual, stop key, reading from left to right on the name board is:
