Dear Barbara:

I am writing with regard to the pipe organ upgrade project that includes a few repairs and the replacement of the manual keyboards.

I have spoken with Rock Whiting a few times during which he shared his frustration with the existing keyboards. We also discussed organs in general and what could be done to your instrument to make it more flexible.

The following is three areas of concern that will be addressed:

1. Supply and install a new two manual keyboard unit in the existing console. The keys will be covered with cowbone on the naturals and ebony on the sharps. Tracker touch spring action to be installed with new 6 wire silver contacts. The number of pistons and location will be the same.
2. All of the disintegrating stop tablets will be replaced with new tablets with the same style of engraving.
3. Add a new stop, Nazard $2 \frac{2}{3}$, to the swell organ by borrowing from the existing Viola 8' pipes. This stop will have it's own stop control located in the swell stop section and will have an electronic switch added to the existing system to obtain the desired pitch. The addition of this stop will necessitate that we relocate an existing control tablet; therefore the Swell Unison tablet will be relocated to the left near the current indicator lamp. In this location the Unison will not be the combination action.

cost of the proposed work is as follows:

1. Supply and install new keyboards as outline,
wired and soldered \$14,140.00
2. Supply and install 26+1 engraved tablets \$1,691.00
3. Supply and install all necessary switching and
control for Nazard 2 2/3 stop to swell.
~~Relocate Swell Unison tablet~~ \$2,010.00


All cables will be wired and soldered.
