

## DESCRIPTION OF THE NEW ORGAN AT OLD ZIONSVILLE

**OLD ZIONSVILLE:**—Last Sunday the New Organ purchased by the Reformed Church was dedicated. Services were well attended. In the morning Rev. Charles E. Schaefer occupied the pulpit, preaching in German, and Rev. Mauser preached in English. There was an address by Rev. Eli Keller in the afternoon, when Rev. Mauser preached in English, and Rev. Shaffer, in German. At the evening service, Rev. Bartholomew preached in German and Rev. Mauser, in English. The collections during the day amounted to \$135.00. There were services on Wednesday evening, when Rev. Noll, of Perkasie, preached and there will be services on Saturday evening, when Rev. Lutz, of Pottsville, will preach. The following is a minute description of the mechanism of the organ. Same was prestied over at the three services by Prof. C. A. Marks, of Allentown.

Andrew Garagis donated one thousand dollars to the organ and the fifteen hundred was collected through John Stoudt a member of the consistory.

The writer wishes to make a remark that was passed by at the fiftieth anniversary, celebrated at Trexletown, in honor of their organist, Frank Kuder, he being personally present on the occasion. On a very warm Sunday afternoon, Rev. Thomas Reber, then pastor, held services. He announced the number of the hymn, not reading it as was the custom, but added that the whole hymn should be sung. So Prof Kuder started in, sang three verses turned on his seat, faced the minister, the later remarked, I said sing the whole hymn. Whereupon Prof Kuder remarked, "You preach a while, it is too hot to sing so long, then we will sing again.
