Please get out immediately the following materials:

Referring to the organ we are building for the First Baptist Church, Cortland, N.Y. #5683, please make the following changes on all copies of the specifications.

Omit from contract the four lines "Echo Organ Floating by Pistons 1-2-3-0, Chimes Floating by Pistons 1-2-3-0, 8' Harp Floating, and 4' Celesta Floating.

The specifications to be changed from three-manual and Echo to four-manual; Echo Organ top manual instead of floating; Chimes remaining played from Great and Echo, located in Echo; Harp and Celesta playing in great and Choir.

Add to contract the following Couplers:

Echo to Great 4', Echo to Great 16', Echo to Choir, Echo to Swell Echo to Pedal, and take out couplers "Echo "On" Great "Off"

Under Adjustable Combinations Pistons 1-2-3-4-5 are to affect Great only, and a separate group 1-2-3-4-5 affect Echo.

Great Organ to be 61 note Chest, Swell Organ 73 notes Chest, Choir Organ 73 notes Chest, and Echo Organ 73 note Chest.

Great Organ all on 6" wind Pressure, except Nos. 5 and 13, which are on 10" wind pressure; Choir Organ #39, Unda Maris, to be Tenor C; Echo Organ #51, Flute Celeste, to be Tenor C.
