The price quoted is for Organ delivered in Church, ready to play, all freight, drayage and erection expenses paid by the Builders, except that the Service Wires from the main Switch-Board to the Organ blower and the Wind Pipes from the Blower to the different divisions of the Organ are to be furnished by the Purchasers.

Four narrow groups of pipes with pipe rail for front to be furnished by builders.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, made this 15th day of March 1924

by and between HILLGREEN, LANE & COMPANY, OF ALLIANCE, OHIO, party of the first part, and

St. John's M.E. Church South, Waco, Texas party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: The party of the first part, in consideration of the agreements hereinafter named, to be made by the party of the second part, hereby agrees to build, install and sell to the party of the second part a Two Manual and Pedal Organ, according

to the specifications annexed, said Organ to be erected complete and ready for use in St. John's M.E. Church South, Waco, Tex on or about the 15th day of July 1924 subject, however, to delays from causes properly recognized as beyond the control of the party of the first part.

Should said Organ, after completion, and upon examination by a competent and disinterested expert employed by the party of the second part, be found not to accord with specifications and terms of these agreements, said party of the first part agrees, at its own cost and expense, to at once make good any deficiency, or failing in this, to remove said Organ from the building, and refund the payments advanced by the party of the second part, who shall no longer be held by the terms of these agreements.

The party of the first part further agrees, at its own cost and expense, for the term of one year after the completion of said Organ, to remedy any and all defects that may develop therein, this undertaking, however, not including tuning nor such care of the instrument as is necessary to insure its normal preservation.

And the party of the second part, in consideration of the agreements herein of the party of the first part, hereby requests the party of the first part to install said Organ, and agrees to purchase the same, paying therefor the sum of Six Thousand, Four Hundred Seventy five Dollars (\$6,475.00) as follows:

(1). ~~Upon the signing of this agreement, the sum of \$~~
(2). ~~When the chief component parts of said Organ are constructed and assembled in the Factory of the party of the first part, the sum of \$~~

(3). Upon completion of the instrument in accordance with the agreements herein, the balance of said contract price, namely, the sum of \$2,500.00 cash on completion of organ in building and the balance in five equal semi-annual payments beginning six months after delivery of organ. Note to bear 6% interest from date of delivery of organ.

It is further agreed by the party of the second part that said building and Organ Chambers shall be in readiness for the erection, tuning and regulating of said Organ, including the conveniences of light, heat and power and subject to the possession of representatives of the party of the first part for the period of 7 days next, previous to the specified time for completion of the Organ, and that the party of the second part will have the Organ examined immediately upon its completion and in the presence of a representative of the party of the first part.

And the party of the second part further agrees, at its own expense to provide the necessary plumbing and electric wiring, furnish the required Wind Conduits from Blower to Organ, and assume the expense of the cutting of such parts of the building, as may be necessary for the proper installation of the Organ.

And the party of the second part further agrees to assume all risks of damage to said Organ, or parts thereof, when placed inside the building it is to occupy; to receive the Organ upon its arrival, cart it to the building, and pay the freights thereon, said freights and cartage to be deducted from the price of the Organ, and such reception and care not to be construed as an acceptance of said Organ. It is also agreed that the party of the second part shall place upon the instrument, in some reliable Company, adequate insurance for the benefit of the parties hereto, as their respective interests may appear.

It is mutually agreed that in the event of a note or notes being given for any balance of said contract price, the title to and ownership of said Organ shall be and remain in the party of the first part until such note or notes, with accrued interest, shall be paid in full, and in default of payment of any such note or notes, with interest, then all the sum represented by said note or notes, and interest, shall become due and payable, and the party of the first part is hereby authorized at their option to take possession of said instrument without legal process, and all payments heretofore made shall apply as rental for use of said Organ.

It is further agreed that the terms of this agreement shall apply to and bind the heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns of the respective parties.
