- 3. The party of the first part guarantees the action and construction of the organ for a term of five one-year from date of completion and agrees to correct defects in material or workmanship that may be brought to his attention within that time, without cost to the party of the second part. This does not include tuning or ordinary care of the organ (or electric motors which are guaranteed by the manufacturers for one year).
- 4. In consideration of the above, the party of the second part agrees to pay M. P. Moller, Inc., or order, the sum of Seven. Thousand. Two hundred dollars. 20/100......

AS FOLLOWS: Three Thousand dollars on satisfactory completion and acceptance and balance in four equal consecutive semi-annual notes bearing interest 5% per annum.

- 6. The party of the second part also agrees to insure the organ or its parts against loss by fire, water, etc., as soon as the parts are placed in the building, for the benefit of the parties hereto, as their interests may appear.
