GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

1 CONSOLE

The present console shall be rebuilt entirely. Only the manual key-boards, podal keyboards and present casing shall be used in the rebuilding. All keys to be rebushed and refinished.

The console action, including combination action, is to be the Moller standard electric type, exactly as used in the organ at St. Thomas R. C. Church Wilmington, Dolaware.

2. WIND CHESTS

he present wind chests to be rebuiltas follows. - all pouches to be releathered with first grade imported lamb skins. The present membrane stop action in wind chests to be replaced with the modern Moller stop action. All pouches and primary action to be releathered. Bridges shall be put on bottom of chest for all separation of bottom boards as well as machine screws to be used for bottom boards.

3 REGULATORS

All regulators to be releathered with first grade sheep skin.

4. SHADE PNEUMATICS

Present shade pneumatics to be recovered.

5. SWELL BOXES

The Swell organ Swell b ox to be enlarged as necessary to receive pedal reed stop.

6. PIPE WORK.

The pipes of the present organ are to be used but all are to be thoroughly repaired, cleaned and revoiced. All new pipes to be of cast spotted metal, excepting for the basses which are to be of zinc.

7. BLOWERS.

The present blower and generator shall be used after being put in first class condition.

It is mutually understood and agreed that parts of the present organ not distinctly specified horain are to be used as is, excepting that the organ builder shall correct any defects in any part which exists at the time of organ installation.
