T H E D U O - A R T P L A Y E R (Entirely Automatic)

- 66. By means of the Duo-Art player, in conjunction with Aeolian Organ Duo-Art records, the stops, tempo, expression, etc., are automatically operated. Six records are included for testing purposes.

T H E S O L O P L A Y E R (Semi-automatic)

- 67. By means of the Solo player, in conjunction with Aeolian Organ "solo" rolls, or Aeolian Duo-Art records, the stops, tempo, expression, etc., are controlled by the performer. (Suggestive use of stops, tempo, expression, etc., is indicated on the Music Rolls and Records.)

GENERAL DETAILS OF CONSTRUCTION

- (A) LOCATION- The Organ is to be located and installed in the chamber prepared for it by the purchaser, in the basement directly below the main floor hall. There is to find egress into the living room and hall through wall tone openings.
- (B) CONSOLE- Console to contain two manuals and pedals for key playing, also Duo-Art and Solo Player, and to be equipped as per foregoing specifications, is to be located to the right of the entrance into living room as you enter the room opposite the tone openings.
- (C) CASEWORK- Screens and grilles for organ tone openings are not included in this proposal.
- Casework for console is included. The Aeolian Company's detailed drawings and hardware for same are to be furnished the purchaser by The Aeolian Company.
- (D) BLOWING PLANT-
- An efficient electric blowing plant is to be provided by The Aeolian Company, and installed in a basement room prepared for the purpose. Also, a low voltage generator to be provided by The Aeolian Company; also a remote control starter to be provided by The Aeolian Company.
- (E) PURCHASER AGREES -
- To prepare organ chamber and blower room according to dimensions and specifications of organ builder; to install necessary galvanized iron wind trunking and conduiting from blower room to organ and console; to connect the blower and remote control starter to the power current, including switches.

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C O N T R A C T

The undersigned, THE AEOLIAN COMPANY, hereby agrees to build and deliver F.O.B. Garwood, N.J., an Aeolian Organ, in accordance with the foregoing specification and general details of construction (which are hereby made a part of this contract), of the highest attainable standard of quality in both workmanship and materials throughout, to ship the Organ on or about January 15th, 1928, and to install in the residence of purchaser MR. RUDOLPH HOKANSON, at Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on or about                      unless delayed by fire, water, strikes, or other causes beyond our control, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen thousand and no/100ths Dollars (\$15,000.00), payable in New York Exchange, as follows:

Two Thousand and no/100ths - - - - - (\$2000.00) Dollars  
upon signing of this contract;

Two Thousand and no/100ths - - - - - (\$2000.00) Dollars  
when organ is ready for shipment from Garwood, New Jersey;

Eleven Thousand and no/100ths - - - - - (\$11,000.00 Dollars  
when organ is installed in above residence; it being understood that in the event of delay in shipment or installation caused by purchaser for any reason whatever, the purchaser agrees to pay any necessary charges for storage or incidentals pertaining thereto; to make second payment when the organ is ready for shipment, and within sixty days after the said approximate shipping date, to pay the entire balance of said purchaser price less an amount of fifteen (15%) per cent of the total price, which amount shall be withheld until installation of the organ.

It is further understood and agreed that said organ is at the risk of said purchaser, on and after its arrival on purchaser's premises, against damage by fire, water, or any other cause not due to negligence or fault of The Aeolian Company, or its employees, and the title to said organ shall remain in The Aeolian Company, until said organ is fully paid for as hereinbefore provided.

The foregoing contract covers all agreements and conditions between the parties thereto, and becomes valid when accepted by both the purchaser and a duly authorized executive of The Aeolian Company.
