

Charles M. Courboin, Belgian Organist, To Be Heard At The Peabody Thursday Night

THE opening recital of the Peabody Conservatory's summer school series, arranged for Thursday night at 8.30 o'clock, will be given by Charles M. Courboin, eminent Belgian organist who is now teaching at the school. Several years ago, Mr. Courboin was selected by Leopold Stokowski to play Widor's Sixth Symphony as soloist with the Philadelphia Orchestra, and the organist is also widely known through his concert tours of this country.

Finding it impossible to arrange for a Sunday night recital by Mr. Courboin, because of his participation in a series of coast-to-coast radio programs, officials of the Peabody selected Thursday as the opening date of the series. Mr. Courboin will play;
