ARTICLES OF AN AGREEMENT, made this
30th day of October, A. D., 1905, between
ERNEST M. SKINNER & COMPANY, of Boston, Mass.,

Parties of the First Part
and *First Congregational Church,*
Collinwood, Ohio Party of the Second Part,

For and in consideration of the Sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.), to be paid by the party of the second part to the parties of the first part, the said parties of the first part agree to build an organ according to the annexed specifications, in the most thorough and artistic manner, and install it in the FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH, Collinwood, Ohio, complete in every detail, and fully warranted, as soon as is consistent with good workmanship.

The parties of the first part guarantee the organ to be first class in every particular, and agree to make good, at any time, at their sole expense, any defects which may develop in the material, workmanship or principles used in the construction of same.

The party of the second part agrees to allow suitable convenience and opportunity ~~in~~ the church for the speedy installation and completion of the organ; to keep the building at a proper temperature for tuning and regulation; to allow the use of the motor for tuning, and to afford a condition of complete quiet for the proper tone regulation and tuning of the instrument.

The party of the second part agrees to insure the organ in the name of the parties of the first part for such time as it remains unpaid for, as soon as it or its

parts have been deposited in the church.

It is agreed that the title to the organ shall belong to the parties of the first part until all payments, cash and deferred, have been made, after which it shall be given to the party of the second part.

The party of the second part agrees to pay to the party of the first part, the sum of Two thousand Dollars (\$2,000.), upon the completion of the organ in the church, to the satisfaction of D. R. D. H. Patterson, Chairman of the Committee, or at latest sixty (60) days thereafter.
