

**THE NEW CHURCH.**

Macedonia church was founded in 1883 and was rebuilt in 1850, but in 1884 the congregation had increased to such an extent that the old church was torn down and the present one erected. The church is of brick, with a front of 45 feet and a depth of 75 feet. On the first floor is the lecture room or Sunday school department, and the class rooms, with a total seating capacity down stairs of about 400. The lecture room has been used for worship for about a year, and the auditorium, with a seating capacity of about 500, has just been completed. The building is finished with stained glass windows, the front windows being the gift of the Sunday school. A pipe organ is located in the gallery, and the choir yesterday was composed of twenty two voices with cornet accompaniment. The cost of the church was about \$9500, of which about \$4000 was raised before the dedication, and together with the amount pledged yesterday makes a total of about \$5000.
