Church Organ.—Mr. Henry Berger, organ builder, has erected in the beautiful Catholic Church, Georgetown, D. C., a large and powerful organ, which, having been subjected to a thorough test, has been pronounced a superior instrument in every respect. The College at Georgetown have also provided, from the same Baltimore establishment, an organ of sweet tone and delicacy of touch, which likewise has pleased the congregation. The hands in Mr. Berger's shops are now engaged in building a powerful organ for St. Joseph's Church, (Catholic,) of this city, and three others, also of large size, for Philadelphia, which are advancing to completion. One of these is for St. Augustine's Church.
