The party of the first part further agrees to remedy all defects for the term of three years resulting from the use of improper material and workmanship.

The party of the second part does hereby agree to pay to M. P. Moller or his order the sum of \$1600.00 at completion as follows: \$1200.00 in cash and one note for \$400.00 due on or before one year after date, bearing interest at 6% per annum.
