Six toe pistons affecting the Pedal stops only.

Ten thumb pistons affecting all stops and couplers of the entire organ, duplicated on toe pistons.

General Cancel thumb piston.

Setter thumb piston.

Great to Pedal, thumb and toe pistons.

Swell to Pedal, thumb and toe pistons.

Full Organ, thumb and toe pistons, with indicator light.

ADDENDUM II

ADDENDUM to the Agreement dated November 21, 1991, by and between The Reuter Organ Company, Lawrence, Kansas, the Builder, and First Presbyterian Church, Cedar Falls, Iowa, the Purchaser, witnesseth:

It is mutually agreed by both parties hereto that the following change and addition shall be made in the stoplist of the pipe organ as covered under the above-referred to Agreement.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

- Delete: CASEWORK None. Such pipes as will be in the facade will be of zinc, with aluminum finish, and poplar stained.
- Insert: CASEWORK None. The Principal pipes 1-12 and the Octave pipes 1-16 in the facade will be of flamed copper. All exposed pipework will be of spoked metal and stained poplar.

In consideration for the above change and addition, the Purchaser agrees to pay to the Builder the additional sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred (\$2,200.00) Dollars, plus any applicable taxes, in funds as follow:

Upon the signing of this Addendum, the sum of \$1,100.00.

Upon delivery to the church, the sum of \$880.00.

Upon completion of the installation, the sum of \$220.00.

All other terms and provisions of the said organ contract shall remain unchanged.
