Gentlemen:

We hereby propose to do the following work on the Aeolian organ in your church. As this work involves several separate operations, on which you have been quoted separate prices, and which may be done at different times, we are listing them separately so that each may be billed and paid for when completed.

1. To furnish and install a new Remote control combination action together with new silver contacts for the stop action in the console. This work to begin on your acceptance of this proposal and to be completed on or before August 31, 1949.

The price of the work listed above shall be \$7,000.00 payable as follows:
25% on signing this agreement and the balance on completion of the work.

2. To clean, tone regulate and tune the organ.

The price for the work listed above shall be \$1,500.00 payable as follows:
25% when the work is begun and the balance on completion of the work. Such completion to be at a date no later than the date specified for item 3 below.

3. To make the additions of the sets of pipes and action, and substitution of sets of pipes, to revise the tonal structure of the organ in accordance with the proposal made in paragraphs 3 to 5 on page 3 of our letter of July 14, 1948. It is the intent of this proposal that it cover all costs of labor, material and expense to do this work. This work to begin on your acceptance of this proposal and to be completed on or before August 31, 1949.

The price of the work listed above shall be \$8,330.00 payable as follows:
25% on signing this agreement and the balance on completion of the work.

Our promise of completion, as stated above, is subject to delays from causes beyond our control.

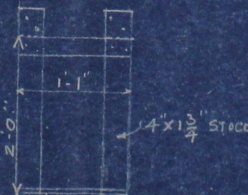

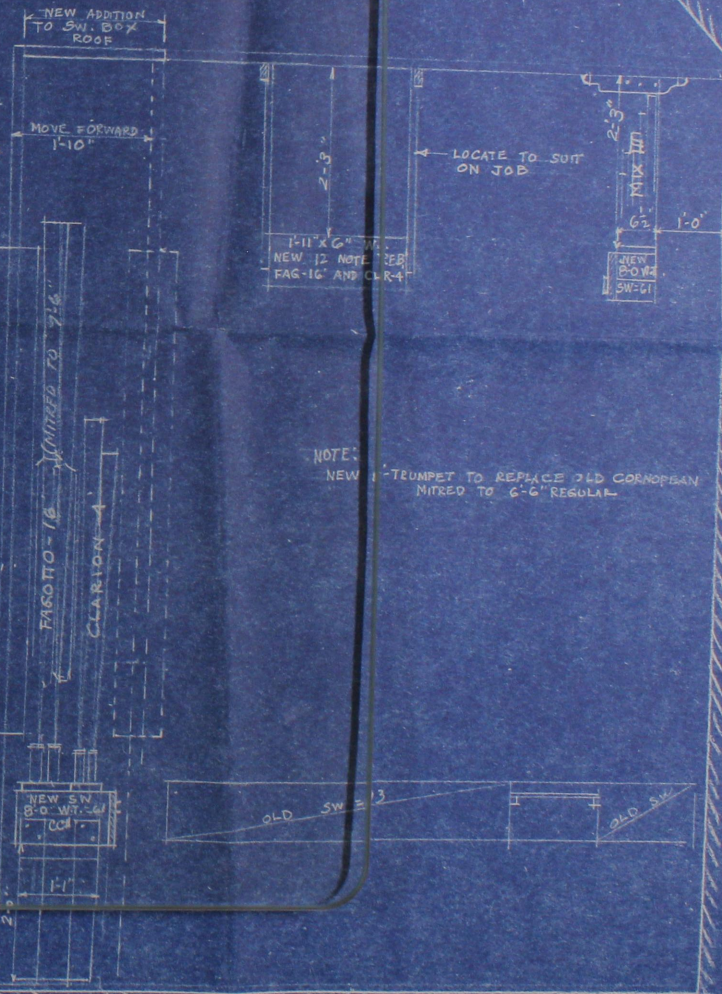
